The inaugural lecture was by Dr. Josukutty C A, Associate Professor, Department of Political Science, University of Kerala on the topic “Human rights as ethical innovation of contemporary times” on 17 December 2020. In this lecture Dr. Josukutty has discussed the evolution of human rights as we perceive in the modern era and the debates related to it. The second invited lecture was on “Youth and changing nature of Indian democracy” on 02 March 2021 by Gismon Thomas, Faculty, Department of History, Mar Thoma College for Women, Perumbavoor. The lecture has discussed the transformation occurred in Indian democracy since independence. The speaker has also mentioned the contributions of youth in a democratic society with special reference to India. The final lecture was by Dr. M V Bijulal, Assistant Professor, School of International Relations and Politics, M G University, Kottayam on “*Kudiyetta thozhil avakashagal: desha rastra vyavaharagalude parimithikal*” (Migrant labour rights: limitations of nation states).
