ACTION TAKEN REPORT

2019-20

This year the institution collected feedback from four stakeholders viz - students, alumni, parents and teachers on various aspects. Altogether feedback on 7 aspects were collected through feedback questionnaire forms. Three are analysed and action is taken at the department level. They are:

1. Student's feedback on curriculum.
2. Student's feedback on department.
3. Student's feedback on teachers.

The feedback on the following aspects were collected and analysed at the college level.

1. Student's feedback on institution
2. Alumni feedback on institution
3. Parents feedback on institution
4. Teacher's feedback on institution

The detailed report on feedback analysis both at the department level and the institution level were tabled at the IQAC meeting and a detailed discussion was carried out to take appropriate action on the feedback. This report describes the steps that were done in response to input from stakeholders, teachers, and students regarding the academic year. The principal aim is to improve the academic experience and general happiness by addressing the key points brought forward in the feedback. The input gathered revealed a number of strong points and room for development. The college arranged training sessions and workshops to help faculty members embrace cutting-edge teaching techniques and integrate technology into their instruction. The college promoted the use of interactive and collaborative learning tools to improve student engagement and involvement in classrooms by taking into account earlier reports. To improve the learning environment, investments were made to update classrooms and laboratories with cutting-edge machinery and technology. In order to give students additional access, extended

library hours were also introduced. Based on the interests of the students, new clubs and societies were established, and those that already existed were encouraged to host more events and activities. Boosted the quantity of cultural and athletic events to encourage a well-rounded student experience. Training and involvement in intercollegiate competitions received more funding. Additionally, the college has improved its mentorship and counselling programmes to give students better emotional and academic support. Despite the fact that subsequent feedback polls have shown a noticeable rise in student satisfaction. Students have spoken about a more interesting and useful educational experience. The number of people participating in extracurricular activities and events has significantly increased. The decisions made in response to the comments have made the academic year more engaging and fulfilling. There will be constant attempts to maintain and improve the standard of instruction and student life by asking for input and putting improvements into practice.



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
